Celebration of Christian Marriage

Any couple intending to celebrate their marriage in the church are advised to have the Pre-nuptial Enquiry Forms (*church papers*) completed no later than **3 months** prior to their wedding. Your pre-marriage course with Accord should also be completed before your papers are signed (info@accordni.com).

The Marriage Schedule (*civil documents*) (**Ref GRO 446 v06/22**) should also be "served on the Registrar at least 28 days before the date of the intended marriage". (It is recommended that all civil and canonical papers are completed no later than 3 months prior to the wedding)!
