Celebration of Christian Marriage

Any couple intending to celebrate their marriage in the church are advised to have the Pre-nuptial Enquiry Forms (church papers) completed no later than **<u>3 months</u>** prior to their wedding. Your premarriage course with Accord should also be completed before your papers are signed (info@accordni.com).

The Marriage Schedule (civil documents) (Ref GRO 446 v06/22) should also be "served on the Registrar at least 28 days before the date of *the intended marriage*". (It is recommended that all civil and canonical papers are completed no later than 3 months prior to the wedding)!
