Dear Parishioner and Gentle Reader,

The fourth Sunday of Easter is often referred to as Good Shepherd Sunday. Being a shepherd in Israel was not easy because it meant living on the fringes of civilisation. The shepherd had to contend with prolonged periods of isolation and loneliness. He had to be alert, constantly watching over the flock, leading them to fresh pastures and protecting them from harm. Shepherds, like tax collectors and other outcasts, were at the bottom of the social scale.

Jesus assures us in today's gospel that no one will take his sheep away from him. The Father who entrusted the sheep to him in the first place, is infinitely powerful, and those who are under his protection have no need to fear. If God is for us, who can be against us?

Today is Vocations Sunday; we are mindful that every person has a vocation in life to respond to their baptismal calling and to use their gifts to the best of their ability for the betterment of society. As Catholics, we firmly believe that God has a plan for our lives! God calls some to marriage, some to the priesthood, the diaconate and religious life or to live as generous single people. Let us pray then for each other's vocation. For each of us our fundamental vocation is to be compassionate people with a mind through which Christ thinks, a

heart through which Christ loves, a voice through which Christ speaks and hands through which Christ helps. He is depending on us.

The need for dedicated men and women has never been greater, the demands never more challenging and the rewards never more worthwhile.

I like the following story which happened some years ago when the great actor Richard Burton was given a reception in his home parish. After listening to many complimentary speeches, the great gathering of his childhood friends and neighbours was asked if there was anything they would like to hear from the famous actor. After a minute's pause an old priest asked him if he could recite (Psalm 23) "The Lord is my Shepherd" which he had taught Burton in primary school. A strange look came over the actor's face. He paused for a moment, and then he said, "I will, on one condition - that after I have recited it, you, will do the same." The old priest said, "I am not an actor, but, if you wish it, I shall do so."

Impressively Richard Burton began the Psalm. His voice and intonation were perfect. He held his audience spellbound, and, as he finished, a great burst of applause broke from the audience. When it died away, the old man rose from his wheelchair and began to recite the same Psalm. His voice was feeble and shivering and his tone was not faultless. And, when he finished, there was not a dry eye in the room. Richard Burton stood up, and his voice quivered as he said, "Ladies and gentlemen, I reached your eyes and ears, but my old parish priest has reached your hearts. The difference is just this: I know the Psalm, but he knows the Shepherd."
