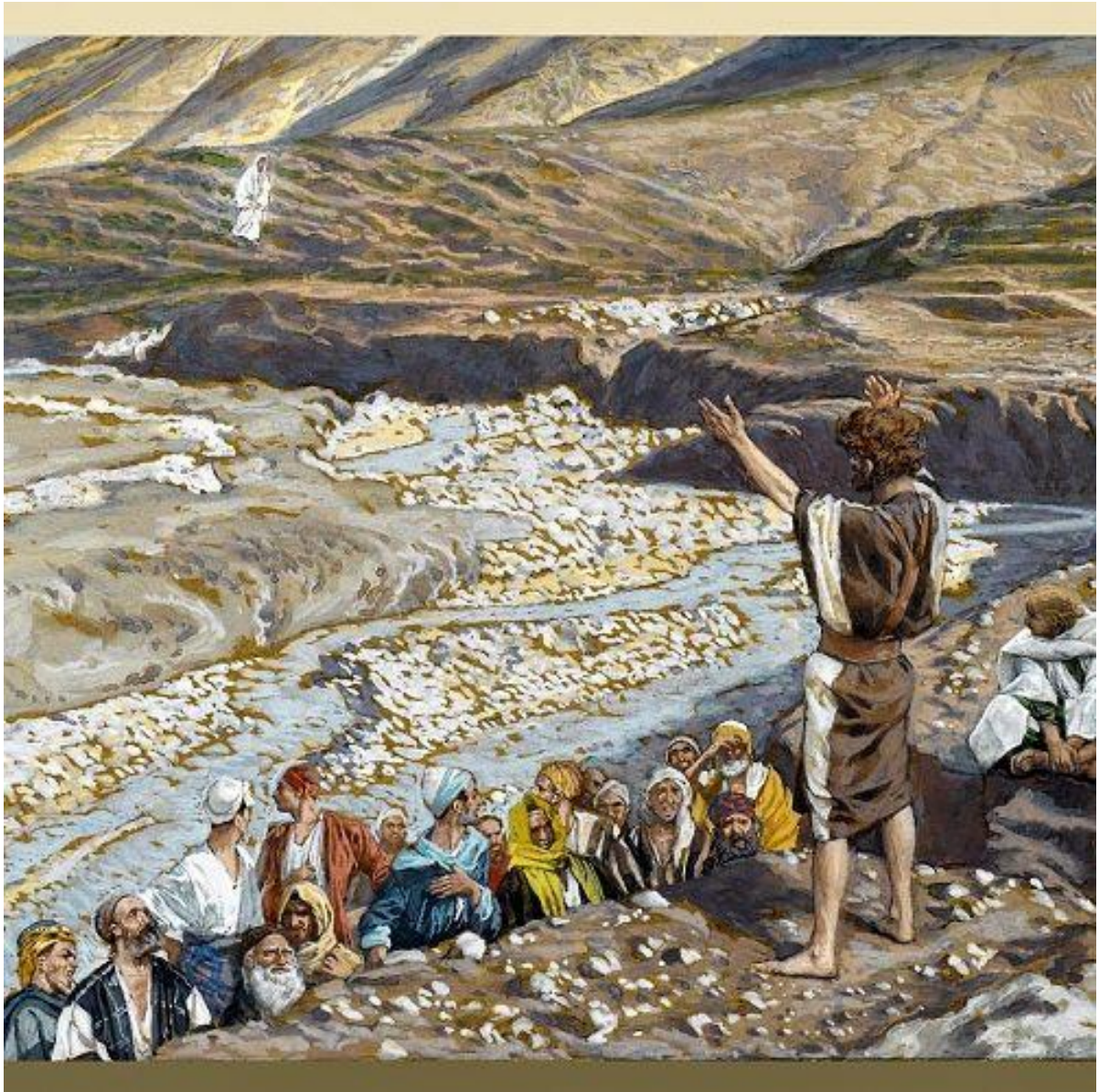

Dear Parishioner and Gentle Reader,

Once again, the subject of today's gospel is John the Baptist - a man who was well known to the scribes and pharisees and other leading Jews of the day. They could not but admire the sincerity of his words and the simplicity of his lifestyle. He courageously spoke the truth, especially the need to be reconciled to God. His message and his personal witness were so persuasive that some questioned whether he was maybe the Messiah, the promised messenger from God. His reply was unequivocal. "I am not the Christ", and he went on to explain that he was only a witness and that one much greater than he would come among them.

Advent invites us to prepare for the one who is much greater and to take time to reflect and allow our spirit to meet God's Spirit:

We await the birth of God's Anointed One.  
Come, O Gift of heaven's harmony,  
and attune my third ear,  
the ear of my heart  
so that I may listen and be alert, like John the Baptist.

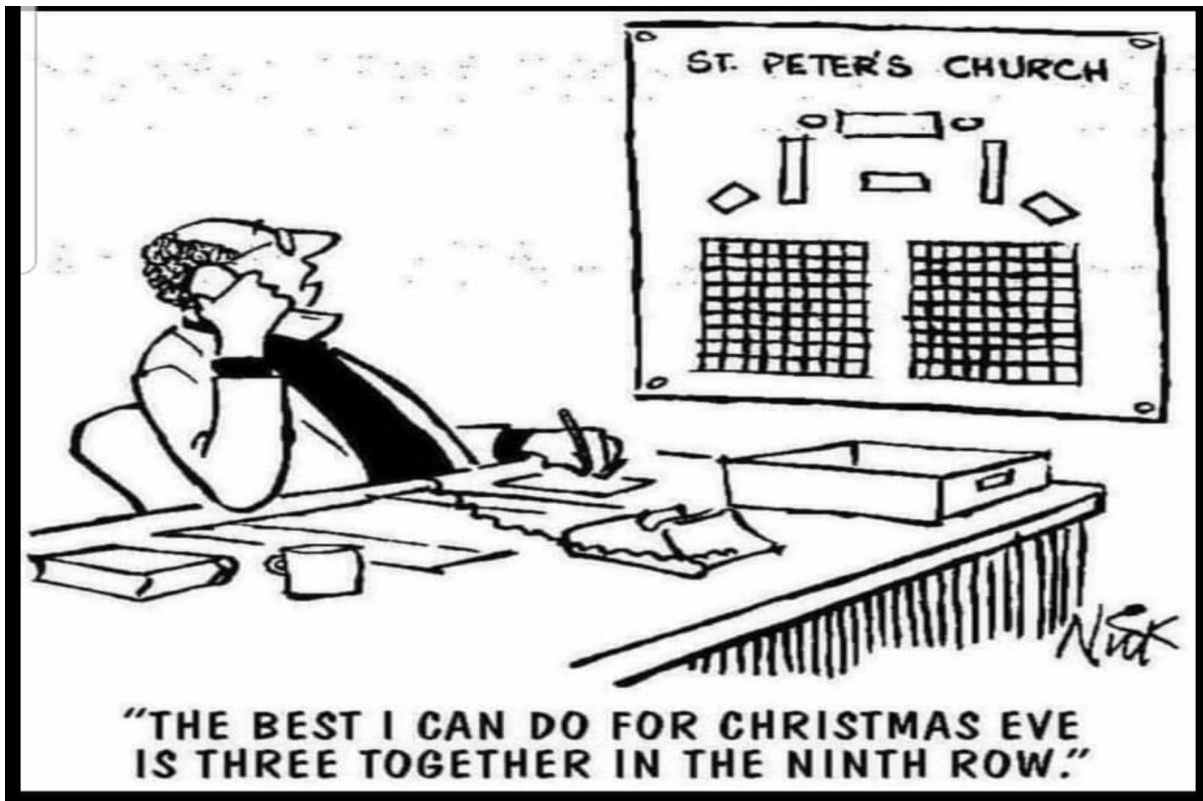
O God, the time is short,

We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen”.*
