### Dear Parishioner and Gentle Reader.

An impending election can evoke many promises and pledges from those hoping to win seats and take their place in government. Canvassing support and seeking votes is the common denominator across all political parties. While it's easy to criticise those who hold political office and bemoan dwindling resources or lack of political vision, we should be grateful for the many advances that have taken place in recent years and for the changed landscape we now inhabit. What has been achieved, albeit far from perfect, is an example to the world that dialogue and negotiation in situations of conflict and hostility is preferable to violence and bloodshed. Something similar is happening in today's First Reading where Paul and Barnabas "put fresh heart into the disciples and encouraged them to persevere in the faith."

We can think of various examples of perseverance in daily life. At this time of year, a great number of young people will need perseverance to get through the final weeks of revision before the exams begin. Many county players will need perseverance to face the daily regime of rigorous training and healthy lifestyle in order to reach the perfection and fitness required by championship football. Then there is the perseverance which is needed by those who are seriously ill, those who are permanently housebound and those facing chemotherapy or other difficult treatments.

We look to Jesus as the model of perseverance. He was so totally committed to the will of the Father that he endured the humiliation of betrayal and the shame of crucifixion. For those who follow him, it will be a similar road of suffering and opposition, a road that will demand perseverance, but in the words of today's opening prayer, a road that "will bear much fruit, and under God's protective care, lead us to the joys of life eternal".
