

## Dear Parishioner and Gentle Reader,

For the past few weeks, the Sunday Gospel has focused on St John's teaching on the Bread of Life and has reminded us of the awesome privilege of receiving the Lord in Holy Communion. This is no casual meeting, but an encounter with the Risen Jesus, deserving our utmost reverence and attention. The Eucharist is the Lord coming to us as the food of life, giving us nourishment and sustenance for our pilgrim journey of faith: "Whoever eats me will draw life from me".

Loyalty and fidelity are at the core of the Readings for this Sunday:

In the First Reading Joshua gathers the tribes of Israel and challenges their loyalty to God; he reminds them of how the Lord has led them to the Promised Land and how he has sustained them on their pilgrim journey. He then gives them a choice in terms of whom they now wish to serve.

The people are in no doubt that they will serve the Lord who has been so faithful to them in the past. "We have no intention of deserting the Lord our God......We will serve the Lord, for he is our God".

In the Second Reading St Paul focuses on marriage as a vocation. He speaks about the very special relationship between husband and wife that reflects the love Christ has for the Church.

Then in the Gospel we observe a separation of the ways: like the people in the First Reading, the followers of Jesus are given a choice. Some find his teaching too difficult to comprehend and feel offended. They drift away murmuring under their breath, "This is intolerable language. How could anyone accept it?" While the believers stay on, some of them are not too sure what is entailed. In answer to the question from Jesus, "What about you, do you want to go away too?", Peter speaks on behalf of the others: "Lord, who shall we go to? You have the message of eternal life?"

This is a scene that has been repeated often down through the centuries. Some still find the message and the practice too hard and walk no more with Jesus.

As for ourselves, we too have to reflect on that question: "Will you also go away?"

# **Week-end Masses**

I am aware that some people in the parish are quite annoyed there is no Mass in St Malachy's, Seskinore on Sunday and no Mass in St Patrick's, Drumduff on Saturday evening, as was the practice in recent years. I share their disappointment, but unfortunately the situation is outside my control. I would love to be able to reinstate the arrangements we had prior to Covid-19. However, the current regulations regarding places of worship are determined, not by numbers in attendance, but by capacity. It is the responsibility of the parish to ensure that the building can safely accommodate people by ensuring the stipulated social distancing, in addition to the other protocols regarding signage, ventilation, and sanitisation etc. Given the size of Seskinore and Drumduff churches, it is not possible to have public week-end Masses until the Health Authorities and the Executive relax the present guidelines.

### Covid-19

While the Executive has decided to ease the restriction of face coverings in places of worship, Church leaders are encouraging people to continue to use them as a precautionary measure against the spread of infection.
