Any couple intending to celebrate their marriage in the church are advised to have their Pre-nuptial Enquiry Forms (*church papers*) completed no later than **3 months** prior to their wedding.

Your pre-marriage course with Accord should also be completed before your papers are signed ([info@accordni.com](mailto:info@accordni.com)).

The Marriage Schedule (*civil documents*) (**Ref GRO 446 v06/22**) should also be "*served on the Registrar at least 28 days before the date of the intended marriage*".

(It is recommended that all civil and canonical papers are completed no later than 3 months prior to the wedding)!
