Tender for Cemetery Maintenance and Grounds Church of the Immaculate Conception, Beragh

1st April 2026 - 31st March 2027

The position of Grounds Person has become vacant and tenders are invited from anyone interested in looking after the Cemetery and the grounds around the Church of the Immaculate Conception and the Parochial House, Beragh. The work includes cutting of grass, hedges, weed control, gutter maintenance and general care taking duties. A tender document, alongside a detailed description of the works, is available from the Parish Office. Please contact the Parish Office to express your interest and for a copy of the tender document. Completed tenders should be received by the Parish Finance Committee **before 3.00 pm on Friday 27th February 2026**.

Beragh Parish Cemeteries

The Parish Cemeteries Committee (in consultation with the Parish Finance and Pastoral Committees) have arranged a survey of each of the Parish Cemeteries. Draft surveys are available to view in each of the Parish Churches. Parishioners are asked to check the details of their family plots and to use the forms provided to make any amendments before the end of January. Parishioners are also requested to identify any graves that remain unmarked; it is intended to use for burial, any areas that are not identified as graves.

This forms part of the review of Cemetery regulations which will be announced to coincide with the completion of the survey.
