Relics of St Margaret Mary Alacoque and St Claude la Colombiére Church of the Sacred Heart, Cloghogue 30th May - 5th June 2025

As part of this year's Jubilee celebrations of the Sacred Heart, the relics of St Margaret Mary Alacoque and St Claude la Colombiére are coming to the Church of the Sacred Heart, Parish of Cloghogue on **Friday 30**th **May at 7.00 pm** and will remain there until **Thursday 5**th **June**.

 St Margaret Mary, a Visitation nun in 17th century France, was chosen by the Lord for a special mission : to make His Sacred Heart known and loved throughout the world. Margaret Mary was not alone in this mission. God, in His providence, sent her a companion and spiritual guide - St Claude la Colombiére, a Jesuit priest and her confessor. St Margaret Mary teaches us to be contemplatives of the Heart of Christ - to sit with Him, love Him, repair for the wounds caused by sin, and offer our lives as a gift of reparation. St Claude teaches us the beauty of spiritual friendship and courage - that the truth, even when misunderstood, is worth proclaiming. Together, they remind us that God's work is often entrusted, not to the strong or the prominent, but to the humble, the obedient, the docile souls willing to suffer for love.
